Government : Anarchy

(Anarchy = where there is NO government), hence, Anarchy is the ANTONYM of Government.

DETERIORATE : IMPROVE

EVASIVE (wordy, too much words with NO clear meaning) : DIRECT

PRODIGAL (extravagant, wasteful): ECONOMICAL (spend as much as need)

PROTRACT (lengthen) : ABBREVIATE

ADULTERATE : PURE

TRANSIENT (fleeting, disappearing quickly, temporary) : PERMANENT

ELATED (joyful) : DEJECTED (crestfallen, sad)

ENSUE (later, following): PRECEDE (back)

TURBID (muddy) : CLEAR

HAMPER (hinder) : FACILITATE

AGGRAVATE (worsen): ALLEVIATE (ease, assuage)

URBANE (wise) : NAIVE
